Greetings,

Thank you for your interest in being a vendor at one of the Twenty-Nine Palms Band of Mission Indians' (Tribe) many events. This packet contains the Temporary Food Facility application, handbook, a picture of a class "K" fire extinguisher, and the checklist that the Tribe's food safety inspectors will use to perform the onsite food safety inspection, just prior to the start of the event you are planning on attending.

In addition to the attached application, please provide the following to the Tribal EPA at [jbrombacher@29palmsbomi-nsn.gov](mailto:jbrombacher@29palmsbomi-nsn.gov) or to your current point of contact with the Tribe and they will pass the required documents to us.

- Proof of Insurance/Certificate of Insurance, showing a liability of \$2,000,000.00 with the Twenty-Nine Palms Band of Mission Indians listed as an additional insured.
- Food Manager's Safety Certificate (ex. ServSafe)
- Food Handlers Cards for all employees that will be handling food at the event.
- A drawing or diagram for the booth, truck, or trailer that you will be using as the facility.
- Vehicle registration if you are a mobile food facility.
- A list of employees expected to work the event to ensure all certifications have been received.

Also please be aware that all food booths require flooring of some type, such as a tarp or matting, that is flat and is easily cleaned. Class "K" fire extinguishers are **required** for any facility that cooks with grease or other food that produce grease-laden vapors.

After passing the food safety inspection, you will be issued a permit that will be good for one (1) calendar year, during which you will be able to attend any Tribal event as a food vendor without an application or inspection; this will still require coordination with Tribal marketing and the Tribal EPA for an invitation.
